This is a basic inventory of contents of the property while it should include most items, it may not be a complete list.

You will be provided access to the property via a 4 digit code we will provide you that access the deadbolt on the patio door (to lock just press the center button and the lock will activate). Inside you will find keys that will unlock the garage door, and both the locks on the patio door. I would advise you to use only the deadbolt lock. If you lock yourself out, there is no easy way to gain access other than having a locksmith pay a visit at your expense. When leaving the property the last time just lock the deadbolt, and leave other keys in the home. You will be provided two house keys, an access card for the clubhouse/pool areas and a remote for the garage door. The house will have an initial supply of all of the basic paper products, soaps and such.

- Has high speed internet wired(cat5) or wireless, login information is posted on wall at desk
- DSL connection on wall – DSL modem on top of computer box
- Two printers- one is a multi function fax/scan print, the other under the desk a laser b/w is set as default printer. Although the multi functions is a color inkjet I have had problems with getting it to print in color, no guarantees.
- Futon fold out bed and pillows are in shams on futon. All bedding, comforter and sheets are in the purple tub in the closet. If you use them leave them out so they get washed and put away clean. The pillow cases are already on the pillows and they are clean.

- TV does not get satellite stations, only local stations using the antennae.

Utility room

- Laundry tub
- Washer
- Dryer(***please clean lint screen after each use***)
- There is a small cordless vacuum to do quick clean-ups as needed and preferred for light clean of living room rug(please leave in charger when not in use)
- Broom and mop in closet******DO NOT** mop the floor with anything other than plain, cold water because of the saltillo tile finish.
- Iron in small cabinet opposite washer
- Ironing board in closet next to laundry tub
- Canister vac in closet to do bedrooms and hard surfaces

Garage

- Has garage door opener and one remote provided
- Main house key also opens garage door
- There is a light on the nightstand in the master bedroom to remind you if you left the garage door open. The light will be flashing red if the door is open, green if it's closed. Check it before you retire at night.
- There is a small shop vac in garage closet
- Our car is plugged into a battery trickle charger, please leave plugged in
- ***You can park additional car next to garage or in front of garage, next door neighbor(Jackie Chanda) has extra car also so be aware of her parking and access to garage needs***

Exterior

- There is a garden hose in garage that can be used to wash car or whatever, water spigot at parking area next to garage
- The front and back patio plantings are on a drip water system that comes on automatically
- There are several outside lights for safety and security. The security/flood lights at door and along walk are on motion sensors, and can be switched using switch by small cabinet in dining room(3 way with one in garage). *Best to leave on and have motion sensors rule.*

Clubhouse/pools(see subdivision map)

There are two pools, neither of which are heavily utilized. The summer pool is not heated. The clubhouse and heated pool is located on N Camino Valle Verde. You can walk direct to the clubhouse via the common area walk paths once you get familiar with their layout. Pool card gains access to pool area, entry is on right side of building, wave card across a white panel by the gate at the front right side of the clubhouse. Clubhouse is accessed only during its open hours 8:00-12:30 (it's posted on the door). There is a library of sorts at clubhouse with many current books and some mags.

Information

TV service is via Direct TV. The DirectTV box is also a digital video recorder so you can easily record programs and such while you are away or as you watch another program, the manual gives all needed instructions. If you set some sort of "record all episodes"

activity, please delete it and any stored programming before you leave. TV set in office is not hooked to the DirectTV system.

Postal Service – You will have to contact USPS and let them know that you will be receiving mail at this address.

Heating and cooling are controlled by thermostat in entry. Change temp using up/down buttons.

Shades- Please be mindful of the shades in the living room. The sun is very strong and will damage the furniture. We would appreciate it if you would keep the shades pulled when the sun is coming in, otherwise you can leave them open and enjoy the view as we do! The shades in the dining room go up very easily by pulling down on them once gently. They will automatically go up on their own. If you're gone for the day, keep them all pulled. Thanks!

Wildlife – You probably noticed the many birds, ground squirrels, rabbits, and lizards, but we also have coyotes and javelinas. Keep the gate and garage door closed in the back.

Problems - call us - clubhouse and onsite maintenance staff **are not** responsible for in unit maintenance.

Trash - collection is on Thursday, **early** morning, **so put the bins out the night before**. You need to put bins out at left side of drive with the open side facing outward for mechanized dumper. The pavement is marked 'T' and 'R' (trash and recycling) anywhere along that side is okay. Leave a space of about 3 feet between the two containers. Collect them the next morning after pick-up. There's a trash container under end cabinet of island.

Pets –You are required to clean up after your pet at all times in Colonia Verde. Make sure you take a bag with you while walking around and dispose of the waste properly. While out and about, make sure your pet is on leash. We have left a kitchen rug for you to place your dog's water and food bowls on. Please use this to keep the floor dry around the bowls. The rug is rolled up located in the cabinet under the bar in the dining room.

Fans - There are two fans for the unit if needed. One is located in the master bedroom , the other in the extra bedroom.

Phone – 520 722-0150 – is equipped with voice mail. If you hear an odd sort of dial tone that would indicate you have a message. Dial *98 to retrieve (that's an asterisk*98). Fax number is 520 733-5671, has special ring that fax picks up. Please delete all messages prior to your departure. Call if you have problems.

Cleaning supplies – minimal supplies are located in the laundry room closet and some are underneath each bathroom sink and kitchen sink area. Do not clean the floor with anything but clean, cold water if necessary due to the type of tile. Do not clean stains from the rug in the living room. Douse the problem with water and leave a note for the cleaner when you leave. Don't use any commercial products on the rug as it may ruin it. There is a spray bottle under sink marked for cleaning of the saltillo tile floor. Please

only use this sprayer for cleaning spills or whatever on this floor. Spray spill or whatever and wipe up with paper towel or cloth rag.

Linens – your pool towels are in each of the bedrooms as are the extra bed linens. Each bathroom has its own set of complete towels with an extra set in the bathroom either under the sink or in the linen cabinet. There are also extra pillows in the linen cabinet in the master bath.

Electrical – Breaker panels are two, one in laundry room and the other on the outside at end of house(next to extra bath).
